

Minutes of the Snow and Ice Contract Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Mooers held September 22, 2021 at the Mooers Office Complex commencing at 7:00 PM

Meeting: Supervisor Jeff Menard called the Meeting to Order at 7:00PM. Supervisor Menard asked Mrs. Kelly McDonald to lead them in the "Pledge of Allegiance," which she did.

Supervisor Menard explained the purpose of this meeting was to review the proposed Snow and Ice Contract with the County.

Superintendent Gilmore said last year was a good year. He stated in 2019/2020 they spent 310 more truck hours on the road than last year. Superintendent Gilmore reviewed his truck rental rate, which is the price the state puts on the equipment. He said last winter is close to what the county pays us. The issue coming up is fuel. Supervisor Menard said there was a clause in there for fuel. Superintendent Gilmore said he would like to see the fuel adjusted every month. The plow gets 3 miles/gallon when the plow is down. Supervisor Menard did the calculations and reviewed this.

There was discussion on the trucks having GPS to do the County Roads. Superintendent Gilmore said there were ways to do a daily report and someone was coming to train him.

There was talk of taking more state runs.

Councilperson LaCount made a motion to accept the County contract.

Supervisor Menard seconded the motion.

The result of the roll call was 3 AYES (Councilperson Perras, Councilperson LaCount and Supervisor Menard) and 2 NOES (Councilperson Bulriss and Councilperson Breyette).

Therefore Supervisor Menard declared the motion carried.

The Town of Beekmantown has a plow truck for sale and going to auction, are we interested? Superintendent Gilmore is going to look at it.

The Station 2 fuel tank needs to be changed out.

Councilperson Perras made a motion to buy the plow from Beekmantown if Superintendent Gilmore says it looks good.

Councilperson Bulriss seconded the motion.

The result of the Roll Call was 5 AYES (Councilperson Perras, Councilperson Breyette, Supervisor Menard, Councilperson Bulriss and Councilperson Breyette) and 0 NOES.

Therefore Supervisor Menard declared the motion carried.

Adjourn: Councilperson LaCount made a motion for the meeting be adjourned; Councilperson Bulriss seconded the motion. All in favor. Thus, Supervisor Menard declared the meeting closed. Meeting adjourned at 7:40 PM.
